1. All club members are strongly advised to arrange their own personal accident insurance and horse owners should obtain third party insurance.

2. All instructors wishing to teach on the TRC grounds must furnish the TRC committee with a hard copy of their current insurance policy prior to any lessons taking place. Riders may not book lessons with an instructor unless this condition has been met.

3. I agree to help run events to ease the burden and facilitate more activities, competitions and the continued growth and development of our club.

4. I agree that if I have a medical condition that may affect my riding, I will inform the Club Secretary.

5. At Tinahely Riding Club we are committed to respecting and protecting your privacy. The information you provide on this form will be used solely for the purposes of communicating with you as a member of this club. As we are affiliated to the Association of Irish Riding Clubs (AIRC), if you have opted to be a member of the AIRC, your personal information will be shared with them in order to fulfil your AIRC membership benefits and/or services and they may share them with associates for the purpose of fulfilling your full membership benefits and/or services (i.e., insurance providers). I understand that if I do not provide my personal data, my membership cannot be registered with the club and the AIRC. We/AIRC will automatically contact you about your membership, for example, to ensure you receive your membership benefits, to tell you about news, activities and events. This includes sending you email updates, information on other membership benefits, and publishing competition times and results in the public domain. 6. If I am accepted for membership, I agree to be bound by the rules of this club and the rules of the Association of Irish Riding Clubs. I also agree to be bound by the code of conduct for this club and also the Association of Irish Riding Clubs. I understand that membership of the club runs from 1st January to 31st December each year. I have read the data protection information and have given my consent, by signing below, to be contacted by the club and by AIRC for the purposes of my membership.

All persons making use of the TRC grounds are subject to the following Code of Conduct:

- All gates into and within the grounds are to be kept closed at all times.
- Considerate parking by all users is expected within the grounds, having due care and attention to other users and larger vehicles in the grounds.
- All lessons and schooling on the Cross Country Course must be booked in advance, no exceptions.
- Any damage noted within the grounds must be reported to the Committee.
- No dung is to be left in the car park or wash bay.
- Water in the wash bay is to be turned off when not in use.
- No rubbish to be left on the premises.
- All minors must be supervised by an appropriate adult or guardian at all times, whether on foot or on horseback, within the premises and grounds known as Tinahely Riding Club, Coolboy, County Wicklow.
